Morning Prayer also continues daily, Tuesday – Saturday on Zoom at 9am; **Evening Prayer**, Fridays at 5pm.


Thought for the week:

It was good to meet in our churchyard for worship last Sunday and to enjoy the birds singing as we sang — without face coverings too! Thank you to everyone who contributed to the discussions about climate change and creation. We thought about three questions:

- What issue concerns you most about climate change?
- What might the Bible / our faith say about these issues?
- How might we practically respond?

The key concerns were all around plastics and single use

plastic / other materials as well as waste. We had heard the creation story from the Jesus Storybook Bible (as well as Jesus' teaching in Matthew 6) – do look out a copy for a different take on this. Over the autumn we will establish a group to explore ways that we can respond to the climate crisis as a church. Please do pray about whether you might join this group and any actions you might take in your own lifestyle.

Looking ahead....

The 8.00 Holy Communion service will continue to be monthly, on the 2nd Sunday.

Midweek Holy Communion will occur again at 10 am weekly, followed by coffee (or just come at 10.30 for coffee!).

Baby and Toddler group meets on Thursdays, 9.30 - 11.00 am. We will meet in church at first (more space and outside play area) and revert to the hall when the weather turns.

Messy Church continues on the first Friday, monthly, 4-5pm. The next is on 1st October, when we will explore the parable of the great pearl.

Keeping Company is our monthly meeting for those bereaved (at any time). Third Thursday at 3pm, in church. The next is 16th September.

Thursday Teas meets in the community hall offering tea, cake and conversation. Second Thursdays monthly.

Gaynor's Gift is a prayer shawl knitting ministry that anyone can take part in at home. We meet together fortnightly to pray, knit and drink tea. Both in church and on zoom. 2nd and 4th Thursdays. The next is on 23rd September at 3pm.

Harvest weekend is 25/26th September. We hope to have a Harvest supper (fish and chips) with talk for adults on the Saturday evening and a church family picnic (bring your own food) after church on the Sunday. Details to come.
