

Our service both this Sunday and next, is a Parish Communion service, at 10 am, to which all are welcome. As I shall be on leave for the next two weeks, this sheet covers two weeks.

Morning Prayer continues throughout the summer, daily, Tuesday – Saturday on Zoom at 9am; Evening Prayer, Fridays at 5pm

Thought for the week: 15th August is the feast day of St. Mary, the mother of Jesus. Although aspects of her life are remembered at various times of the year, this day is the major celebration. We actually know very little about her but as the pictures on this page remind us, she was with Jesus throughout his entire life – from birth (having said 'yes' to God's most unusual request of her) to his death on the cross. Like all mothers, she worried and was short with him when he got 'lost' at the age of 12 in Jerusalem. She attended a wedding with him at Cana, nearby their family home – and she called on him to help the family when the



wine ran out; knowing that 'her son' could deal with the problem. She turned up one day with his siblings to check he was ok (Mark 3. 31). She was there, at the foot of the cross, at his dying, and received his lifeless body into her arms. She stuck with him, by him, for him, in all circumstances. How true might that be of each of us?
