Week commencing: 3rd January 2021 The Feast of the Epiphany

A very happy new year to everyone.

New year, new start. And renewed hope too as we trust in our incarnate God, who knows what it is to live with the struggles of human life and lifts our humanity up to share his divinity.

It is difficult to know quite how to plan within the current restrictions and concerns about the prevalence of the pandemic right now. This Sunday we will have a service of Parish Communion (not All Age) both live in church and also on Zoom. Please think very carefully about whether you should attend church in person. If you are physically at church please remember that tier 4 regulations mean that we can gather for worship but not mix outside or own households – so please come straight in and take your seat, leaving immediately after the service too.

We will keep you informed via this weekly sheet about services from Monday, but I can confirm now that the Wednesday 10 am service will, for the time being, be discontinued.

I am sorry that we are heading into more isolation, but it is necessary to contain the virus. Contactors will be in regular contact with you and please do feel free to contact your own contactor or myself if you have any needs — or just need human contact by phone or zoom.

We will, of course, continue to offer a Zoom Morning Prayer daily at 9am (except Mondays and Sundays) and Evening Prayer at 5pm on Fridays. The order of service can be found on our website or the Daily Prayer App. Just ask if you need help finding it.
