Week commencing: 21st November 2021 The Feast of Christ the King, Parish Communion

As we come to the end of the liturgical (church) year, our service this Sunday will be a Parish Communion service at 10 am. Just for this week it will not be zoomed, back to zoom for Advent Sunday next week.


Morning Prayer also continues daily, Tuesday – Saturday on Zoom, at 8.30 am (9 am on Sat.)

Evening Prayer, on Fridays at 5pm also on zoom (but note there is no service on 1st Friday monthly).

Thought for the week: 'my kingdom is not of this world'. As Jesus is interrogated by Pilate he is asked whether he is a king. Pilate cannot grasp kingship beyond the earthly sense of dominating power. The world is about to see a whole new way of being kingly – as Jesus dies and is raised to glory – a new king to those who follow him.

We thought recently about how the Kingdom of God is sometimes explained as 'God's dream of how the world could be'. As we come to The end of the church year and reflect on Jesus as king we think about His whole life and teaching and example. God's kingdom is very clearly not 'of this world'. Indeed it is quite opposed or different to the values we see around us.

How do we manage to live 'counter-culturally', as members of Jesus' kingdom?
